## Australian Lions Foundation – “Helping Lions help their Community”

Following the initial requests for assistance from the Districts impacted by the devastating bushfires in Victoria, the ALF approved and immediately provided over \$40,000 to those Districts to use in supporting those in need.

As last week progressed, the real extent of the needs in these areas became more apparent. At the weekend, the Trustees of the Foundation approved increased Emergency Grant funding for these areas.

The following Emergency Grants have now been approved for the Districts and funds forwarded:-

District 201 V3	\$25,000
District 201 V1-4	\$25,000
District 201 V5	\$110,000

It is also wonderful to acknowledge the support of LCIF to these Districts. It just proves that we all work together for a common cause in the desire to support the community.

A provision has also been made to support the other “V” Districts, if the need arises.

We must also be mindful, that in far North Queensland, they are still experiencing the effects of the floods and the Foundation must be prepared to support them in a similar way when they determine their needs. The **Australian Lions Foundation** has made a provision of up to \$50,000 to be immediately available upon request of the Governor.

The **Australian Lions Foundation** is able to respond in such a way because of the generosity and willingness of the Lions family in Australia to support those in need.
