

NSW Emerging Lions Leadership Institute

Emerging Lions Leadership Institutes focus on building the skills of Lions leaders to prepare them for leadership responsibilities at club level, with some grounding for positions at other levels.

Qualified candidates are Lions or Lionesses in good standing that have not yet completed a successful term as club president. Candidates do not have to hold a position currently.

Candidates must be willing to commit to a three-day institute.

Cost of the Institute

Lions Clubs International will pay for each participant's meals and lodging during the actual days of the institute at the training facility. Participants are responsible for their own transportation and related travel expenses to and from the institute and any partner's costs.
