The **Australian Lions Foundation** immediately provided over \$40,000 in Emergency Relief Grants to Lions Clubs in bushfire devastated areas in Victoria to help victims of the fires purchase food, clothing and essentials. The Foundation was established by Lions in 1983 and since that time has distributed over \$1,000,000 to help Australians recover from disasters.

The tragic fires in Victoria have left many communities devastated, but Lions Clubs are in there working closely to provide direct support to the volunteers and those that have been affected even though many have been impacted themselves.

Chairman Paul Logue says:

“We know that families who have lost everything can’t wait for days and weeks for essential services.
