

Australian Lions Pin Trading Club Catalogue of Australian Pins

12th Edition, 2014

INTRODUCTION

Like previous editions of the catalogue which have each expanded by the addition of new and old pins, a total of approximately 2350 are now illustrated with 150 'new' pins added to this edition.

The catalogue has been produced with the object of providing a history of pin production by Australian Lions, as well as a record of pins used for project and other Lions activities in Australia and as a useful listing of pins for collectors. The catalogue has resulted from the extensive efforts of a number of ALPTC members. The making available of 'old' and 'new' pins by members is greatly appreciated

As pins have now been produced for over 50 years it is very difficult to obtain accurate information regarding the production of early pins. Each year a number of 'old' pins have come to light as well as a number of pins now being shown to have probably been produced for a number of years and resulting in more than one variety of the pin.

This 12th edition has seen the rearrangement of two sections, the ALPTC issues and the Personal Pin issues, sections 01 and 21 respectively. This has been done to more accurately indicate the authorisation of the pins.

While every attempt has been made and continues to be made to record all pins, there are many pins, particularly Club, and personal pins which have not made it to this catalogue.

Any information such as year of issue for the pins included here would be greatly appreciated, as would any details of the many pins not included. For pins not included here it would be appreciated if medium resolution electronic image could be provided. Images and any pin details can be emailed to the compiler. New information regularly results in deletions and changes to the classification of pins - sample pins when identified as such are deleted.

Information received will enable the catalogue to be up-dated on a regular basis.

It is hoped that you find this a useful adjunct to your collecting activities.
