

GUIDELINES FOR LIFE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ASSOCIATION.

- 1. Life Membership may be awarded to not more than three (3) Members each year with the number to be awarded and the successful nominee/s being determined by the selection Committee.**
- 2. Such Life Membership/s shall be conferred at the Annual General Meeting and Dinner (“AGM”) in conjunction with the Multiple District Convention.**
- 3. Nominees for Life Membership must:**
 - (a) be a Member in good standing of Lions Clubs International (LCI)**
 - (b) have been a Past District Governor (“PDG”) for at least ten (10) years**
 - (c) following his/her term as District Governor have been actively involved in Club, District and Multiple District affairs**
 - (d) have regularly attended District and/or Multiple District Conventions**
 - (e) have performed outstanding service to LCI and/or the community.**
- 4A. Life Membership shall also be automatically conferred on any Australian Past International Director (“PID”) at the AGM held in the year following the end of his/her term of office or the year following the tenth anniversary of him/her becoming a PDG whichever shall be earlier.**
- 4B. In any year where Life Membership is conferred on such a PID the maximum number of Life Memberships awarded under Clause “1” shall be reduced to two(2).**
- 5A. The Selection Committee shall comprise five (5) PDG’s selected from the Members present at the AGM held one (1) year prior to the AGM at which the Life Membership/s is/are to awarded.**
- 5B. The Members of the Selection Committee shall hold office from the rising of the AGM at which they are elected to the rising of the next AGM.**
- 5C. The Treasurer/Welfare Officer shall be an ex-officio and voting member of the Selection Committee.**
- 5D. The election of the Selection Committee shall be conducted in such manner as is determined by the President then in office of the PDG Association.**
- 5E. The Selection Committee shall appoint one of its number to be Selection Committee Chair.**
- 5F. Any casual vacancy in the Selection Committee will be filled by a PDG appointed by the President then in office of the PDG Association.**

- 6A. Any Past District Governor may nominate for Life Membership any Member who fulfils the nomination criteria in Clause "3). Nominations (with supporting evidence) shall be submitted in writing (which includes electronic transmission) to the Treasurer/Welfare Officer.
- 6B. The closing date for nominations shall be three (3) weeks prior to the AGM.
- 6C. The Treasurer/Welfare Officer shall promptly circulate all nominations and supporting evidence so received to the members of the Selection Committee.
- 6D. Voting shall be in such manner as determined by the Selection Committee and votes shall be cast by post or electronic mail to the Selection Committee Chair.
- 7. A nomination shall stand for one (1) year only. Unsuccessful nominations may be submitted again in subsequent years.
