- Talk it over with your parents
- Contact your local Lions Club for an application form or download from our Web-site.
- Complete the form to obtain medical certificate from your doctor, attach a recent passport sized photo of yourself and send it, with a deposit cheque for \$500 made payable to MD 201 Council before 30 June.
- Follow the next step when advised by Lions.



Can't go away? What about hosting?

If you can't spare the time or haven't saved enough to go on an exchange yourself (this year!), you might consider hosting someone on exchange from another country.

Your family acts as a Host Family in the same way families in other countries would look after you while on Youth Exchange overseas. Lions looks for host families twice a year – in July/August and December/January, for periods of three weeks each (to share the load for the families and the experience for the exchange participant).

You'll need to fill in an application form (available from the web site www.lionsclubs.org.au/ye). Applications for host families close each year on 31 March and 30 September.
